Pole-lathe turning. Once you've discovered the joys of traditional green wood-turning you'll be hooked. From materials selection, axe work and cleaving through to turning your own choice of products (from candle sticks to baseball bats!) this is a highly focused and relaxing two day course, covering a wide range of green woodcraft skills, many of which are transferable to our advanced courses.

Level: Suitable for beginners

Group size: four people

Chair making. Over this five day course you'll create a Welsh borders-style ladder back chair . . . from a log! This course covers a wide range of green wood skills and traditional chair-making techniques resulting in a beautiful chair that will last for generations.

Level: Some previous experience advisable.

Parent and Child. Spend a day with a loved one just mucking about with wood! This one day introduction to green woodwork and pole lathe turning is designed for children (8+ recommended) and parent / grandparent / carer, working closely together as a team. From whittling and knife skills through to turning on a pole lathe, you'll both be guided through the basic techniques of green woodwork - and leave with some finished items to remind you both of your new-found skills!

Level: Suitable for beginners.

Family Green Woodwork. Learn new skills and make all sorts of things as a family unit on this bespoke 2-day course. You'll also learn how to assemble and dismantle a finished yurt, learn variations on style, construction, linings, heating and coverings. This is an inspirational course, which will give you a good grounding in a wide range of green woodwork tools, skills and techniques .
